REGIONAL ARTS FUND

The Regional Arts Fund (RAF) is an Australian Government program designed to benefit regional and remote* arts practitioners, arts workers, audiences, and communities.

The fund is provided through Regional Arts Australia and is administered in Queensland by Flying Arts Alliance. Project Grants provide major funding for high-quality arts projects benefitting regional or remote artists, arts workers, audiences, and communities.

The focus of the project could include any area of creative practice, multiple art forms, or cross-disciplinary practice.

QUICK RESPONSE GRANTS

Regional (MMM2 – MMM7 locations)

Quick Response Grants (QRGs) are open 10 times each year during February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October and November. Quick Response Grants support applications which assist regional artists, arts organisations and communities to take up professional or skills development or small project opportunities.

Quick Response Grants aim to support small arts or cultural projects that cannot be funded by other means because of their nature or timing. For example, you may wish to attend a workshop or complete a project within a certain time frame and cannot access appropriate funding through any other means.

Please note that Quick Response grants are competitive, and as part of your application you will need to detail why your project cannot be funded through other means.

This type of grant would also suit individual professional development. Up to \$3,000 for individuals and \$5,000 for organisations.

ROUNDS OPEN MONTHLY, FEBRUARY - NOVEMBER

For projects occurring a minimum of two weeks after application date.
