Director Jan Manton established the gallery in 2004 with the vision of supporting artists who contribute to the vibrant and dynamic discourse on contemporary art in Australia.



Michael Eather is the Director of Mitchell Fine Art in Fortitude Valley, Brisbane. After operating galleries in both Darwin and Alice Springs in the Northern Territory for over 20 years he opened Mitchell Fine Art in 2015. He has a history of curating and presenting exhibitions around the world over the past 25 years.



Simon Wright has held programming, curatorial and management positions in private, public gallery and museum realms since 1993, having delivered in excess of 350 exhibition and publication projects. Currently Assistant Director (Learning + Public Engagement) at QAGOMA, he was formerly Director of Griffith Artworks + Griffith University Art Gallery (2005-12), and Exhibitions Manager at Brisbane City Gallery (now Museum of Brisbane).



John Stafford has over 35 years' experience in the visual arts as a practising artist, gallery director, curator, lecturer, consultant, board member, bureaucrat, and peer assessor. His curatorial work has included both gallery exhibitions, art strategies and public art commissions. John's professional responsibilities have included a broad spectrum of visual arts including programs for grant funding, public art, design, and First Nations visual arts activity.



Hamish Sawyer is a curator, writer and is Artistic Director of NorthSite Contemporary Arts, Cairns. NorthSite has a fundamental role in ensuring the advancement of contemporary art in Cairns and greater North Queensland, through the on-going development, delivery and promotion of exhibitions, programs, events and provision of artistic services.



Chris Bassi is an artist working with archetypal models of representational painting, his work engages with the medium as sociological and historical text and as a means to address issues surrounding cultural identity, alternative genealogies, and colonial legacies in Australia and the South Pacific.



Jonathan McBurnie is an artist, curator, and Director of Rockhampton Museum of Art. McBurnie began self-publishing comic books at the age of ten, and his life has been a series of constant projects ever since. Completing a PhD at Sydney College of the Arts, University of Sydney in 2014, his thesis and accompanying studio works explored the shifting role of drawing in the digital age. McBurnie approaches his work as a collision of high and low forms.



Peta Rake is the Director and Senior Curator at University of Queensland Art Museum. Her creative practice is currently attentive to transdisciplinary conversations focussed on blue research, working closely with artists and scientists to understand the psycho-social, political and gendered dimensions of coastal wetlands, sea country, intertidal zones, aquaculture and the regeneration and articulation of these sites.
