

Stained Glass Art

Coloured PVA Glue Window Sticker Design

Students will create stained glass inspired art by using the method of making a window sticker from PVA glue. PVA glue dries into a clean film and adheres to windows in a non damaging way. Add colour to the glue so when it dries, the colour retains its transparency appearing like a stained glass window design.

Lesson: 1 x 35mins

Prep time: 5-10 mins

Making time: 15 mins

Drying time: Overnight

Clean Up: 5 mins

Set up:

- Tables with groups of 4-5 students

Materials:

- PVA Glue
- Ink
- Pipettes
- Containers
- Newspaper
- Cling wrap/Acetate



EXAMPLE

Instructions:

1. Use a non-porous/non-stick surface such as a vinyl tablecloth, cling wrap attached to a support or sheets of acetate/OHT).
2. Pour **PVA glue** about the size of a pancake onto surface.
3. Get students to drop in watered down **ink** using **pipettes**.
4. Swirl glue and ink around with a **paddle pop stick**.
5. Allow to dry completely (may feel tacky for a few days).
6. Complete! Peel off surface. Cut to shape if desired. –Stick to window

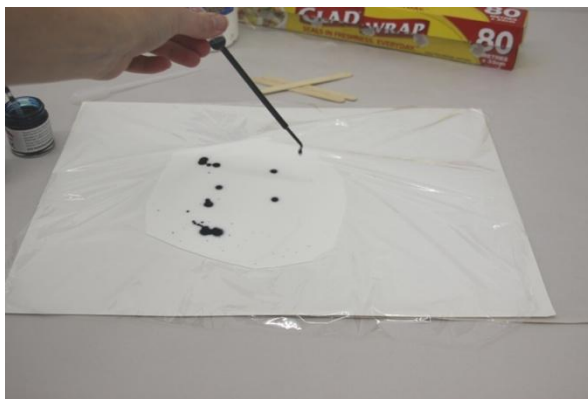
