Quick Response Grant

About this Grant

Quick Response Grants – funding applications for up to \$3,000 are available through this grant program.

Quick Response Grants are intended to assist regional artists, arts organisations and communities to take up professional or skills development or small project opportunities.

Applicants can apply for a Quick Response Grant if their small arts or cultural project cannot be funded by any other means because of its nature or timing. This type of grant would also suit individual professional development.

Using the Modified Monash Model Map

As an applicant it is useful to know your MMM class to ensure you are eligible to apply for this grant.

Applicants living in an MMM2 - MMM7 location are eligible to apply for this grant, however those living in an MMM1 location are not.

To access and search your address in the Modified Monash Model please follow these steps below:

- 1. Visit the <u>Doctor Connect Locator</u> map using the link in this sentence.
- 2.Enter your address in the address bar.
- 3. Select "Modified Monash Model" from the classification options.
- 4.Select "2019" from the drop down options.
- 5.Click "Search location".
- 6. The tool will display your MMM class.

Application Eligibility and Timeline

Applications for Quick Response Grants will be accepted from individuals, groups, incorporated not-for-profit organisations and councils which reside in Queensland postcodes classified as 'regional' according to the Modified Monash Model. MMM1 locations are ineligible, MMM2-MMM7 inclusive are eligible.

Please note that only Queensland residents are eligible to apply for this grant. Please see the <u>Regional Arts Australia website</u> for a list of Regional Program Administrators of the fund in other states and territories.

Although ineligible to apply in their own right, individuals and organisations from excluded areas (MMM1) can participate in RAF-funded project activities as project partners and/or paid participants where the applicant is an eligible regional arts organisation or individual (MMM2-MMM7).

Funding recipients will:

- be required to upload the signed Acceptance of Grant Conditions and invoice at least ten working days prior to the starting date of the proposed project or program to ensure adequate time is available for payments to be processed
- receive funds within **ten working days** of receipt of signed Acceptance of Grant Conditions and invoice
- be required to submit an acquittal report to Flying Arts Alliance within 20 business days of completing the project or program
