Language has passed down lore, culture and knowledge. Words connect Indigenous people to country, an understanding of country and an understanding of its Indigenous people. 2019 is the **United Nations International Year of Indigneous Languages.**

Voice Treaty Truth were key elements to the Uluru Statement from the Heart which is a set of reforms. One of these reforms is to set up a Makarrata Commission to supervise treaty and truth. Treaties are inseparable from truth. Understanding history is needed for true reconciliation – it is the history of all of us, all of Australia and we need to own it. We need to move forward together – lets work together for a shared future.

For our AFTM NAIDOC exhibition Indigenous artists who are socially isolated or live outside of Brisbane are invited to submit work in the spirit of the NAIDOC Week theme. Collective or collaborative works with Non-Indigenous artists will also be considered.
